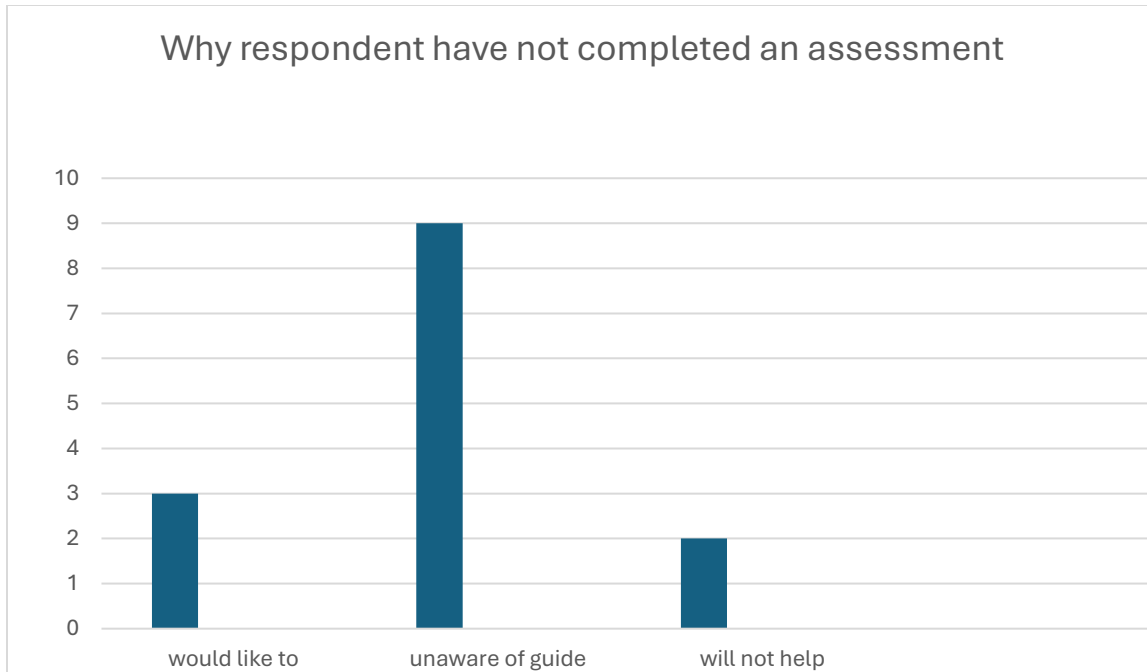




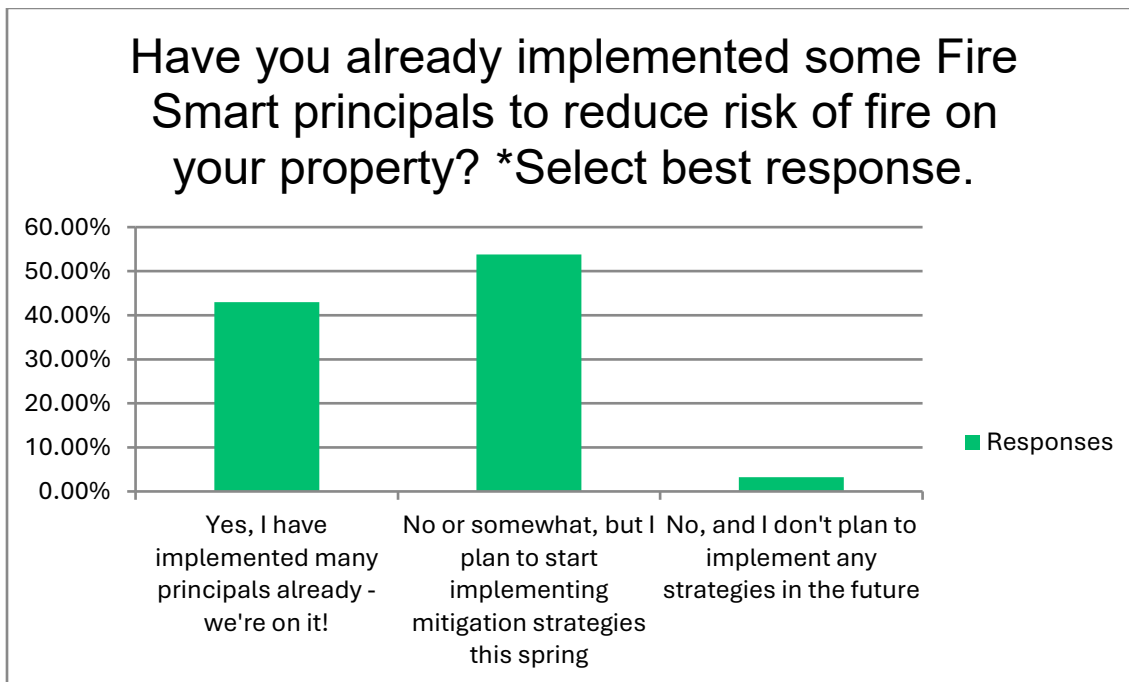
211 respondents (85%) were familiar with the Fire Smart Program



211 respondents of 249 (85%) have completed or plan to complete a FIRE SMART assessment.

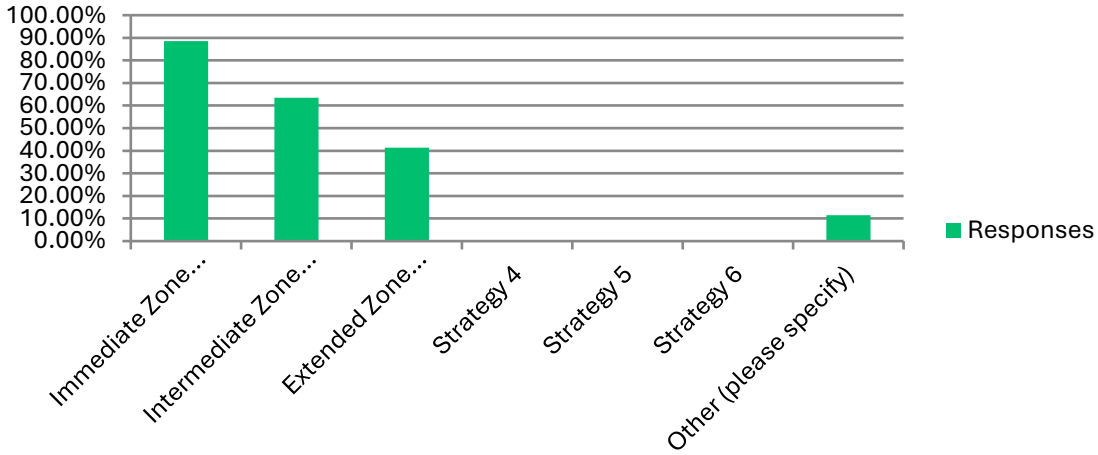


9 respondents had not completed a self assessment because they were not aware of the guide.

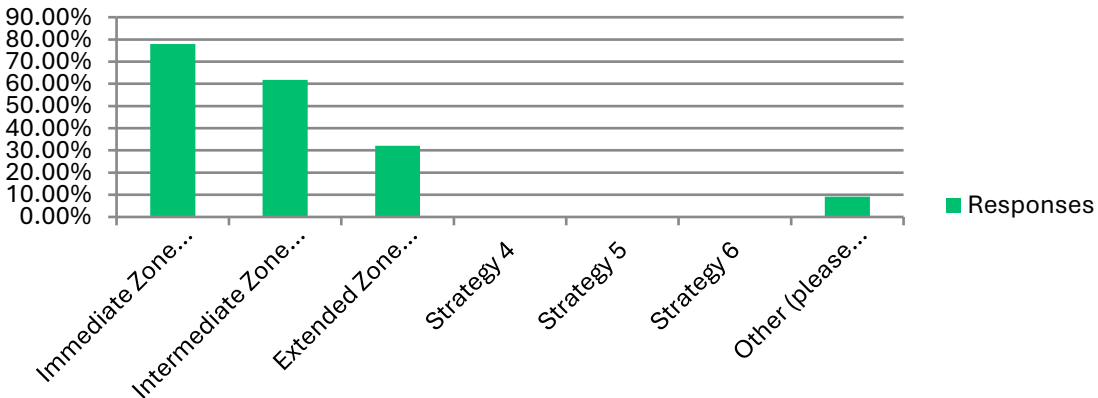


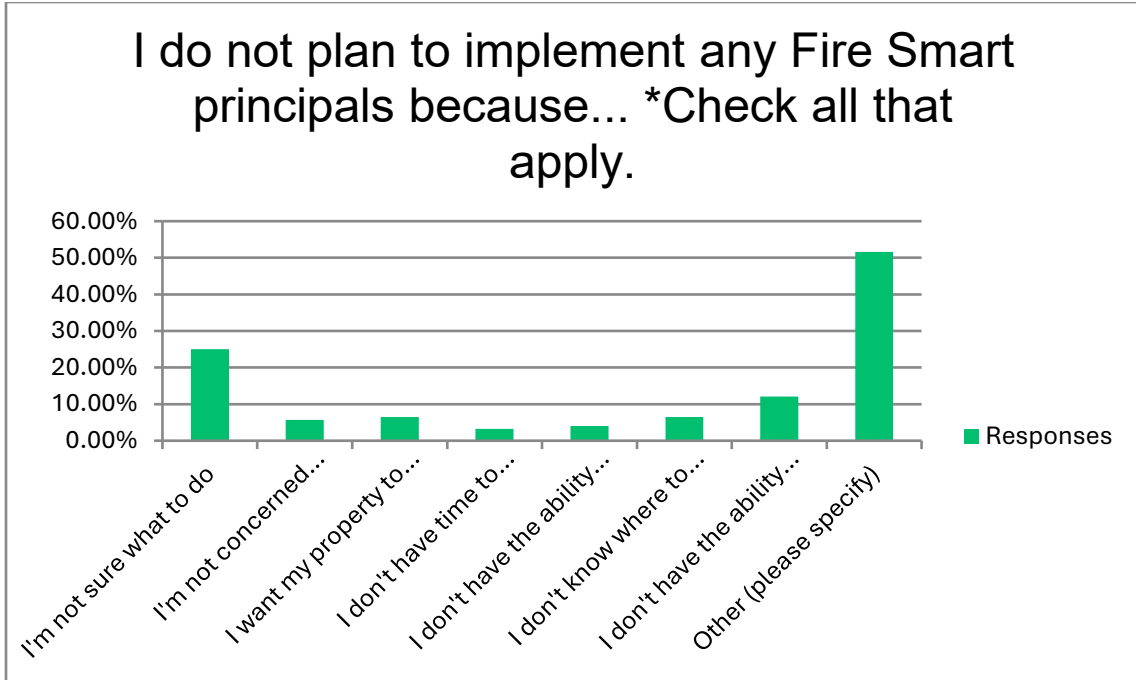
96% of the respondents have implemented or plan to implement FIRE SMART principals on their property.

I have already implemented the following Fire Smart principals to reduce risk of fire on my property. *Check all that apply.

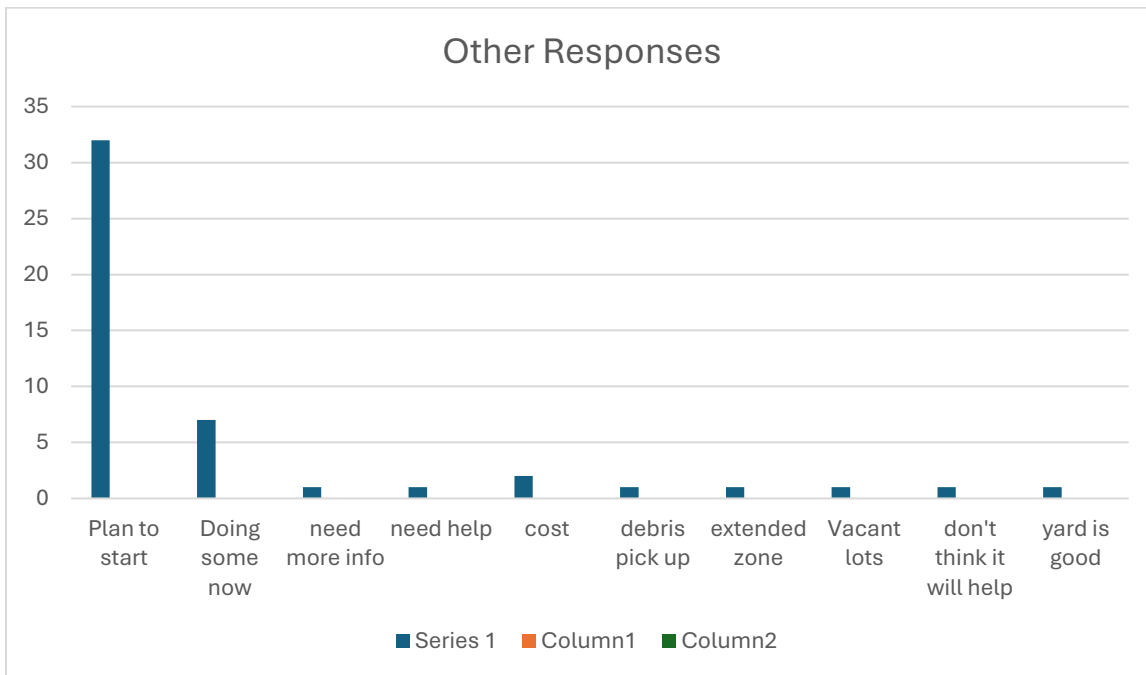


I plan to implement the following Fire Smart principals to reduce risk of fire on my property this spring. *Check all that apply.

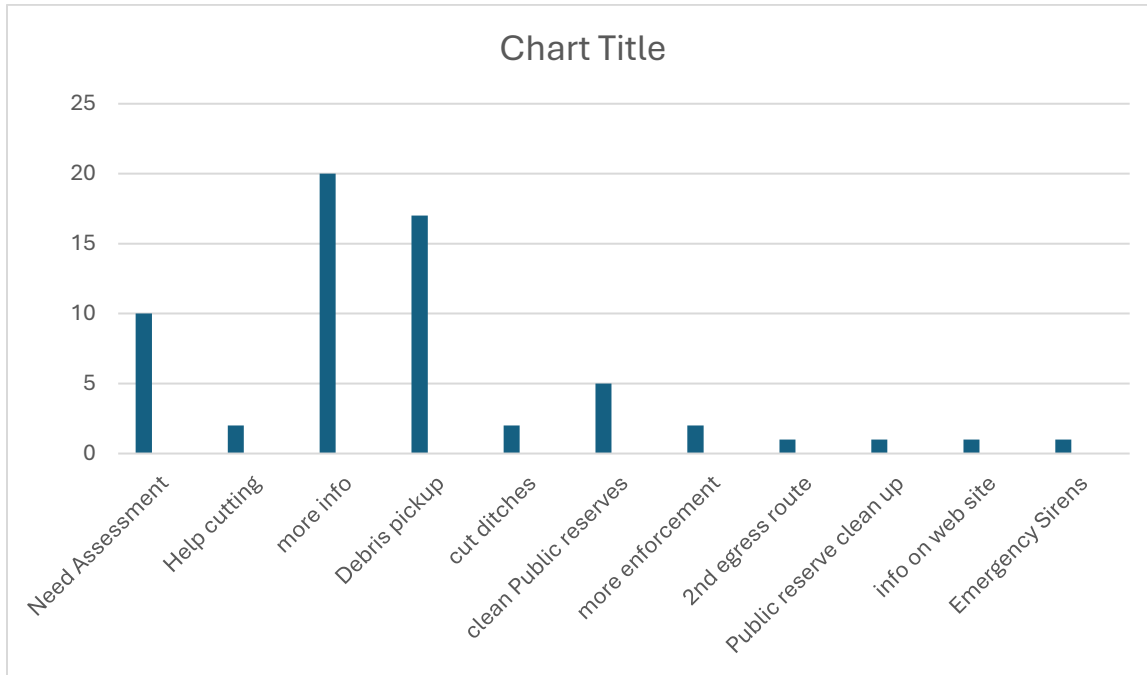




I do not plan to implement any fire smart principals.
