The deadline to submit Property Assessment appeals to the RM of Lac du Bonnet for the the 2027 Preliminary Assessment Roll is **Tuesday, Sept. 8, 2026 at 4:30 p.m.**

The Board of Revision for the 2027 Preliminary Assessment Roll takes place on **Wednesday, Sept. 23, 2026 at 4 p.m.** in the RM of Lac du Bonnet Council Chambers.

A Supplemental Board of Revision will take place on **Wednesday, Oct. 21, 2026 at 4 p.m.** This Board of Revision is only for those who received a Supplemental Tax Bill (sent in the months of August or September 2026) for adjustments to the tax years 2025 and/or 2026.

The deadline to submit appeals for the Supplemental Board of Revision is **Tuesday, Oct. 6 at 4:30 p.m.**

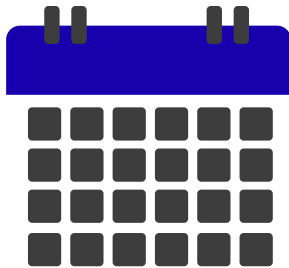
