Council Decisions

Treaty Land acknowledgement:

• Reeve Loren Schinkel and Council opened the meeting with a Treaty Land acknowledgement.

Council Expense Claims for March, 2025:

• The <u>Council Expense Claims for March, 2025</u> were approved.

Off-road vehicle event permit requirement and By-Law development

Establishment of Off-Road Vehicle Committee:

- Council resolved to establish an Off-Road Vehicle Working Group Committee made up of Council members, municipal administration, Public Works staff, local ATV and snowmobile club representatives, and representatives from Provincial Crown Lands.
- Further, they resolved that the Committee follow the Terms of Reference as presented with the inaugural stakeholder meeting scheduled for April 23, 2025, and that the Committee report back to Council with recommendations upon completion of its mandate.

Lac du Bonnet Fire Chief appointment:

- Council appointed Mr. Earl Simmons (left in photo) as the Fire Chief of the Lac du Bonnet Fire Department, effective immediately.
- Further, they appointed Mr. David Lussier who served as Fire Chief for the past 15 years

 as Deputy Fire Chief, effectively immediately for up to six months, so he can continue to
 provide valuable support to the Department and the community.



• Council and the RM extends its sincere appreciation to Mr. Lussier for his many years of dedicated service and leadership and warmly welcomes Mr. Simmons to his new role as fire chief.
