Wood Duck Boat Launch Dredging Project underway

The Wood Duck Boat Launch Dredging Project began in mid-February and will wrap up by March 20, weather permitting. The project will restore a safe navigation depth of a minimum of six feet throughout the boat launch area, expand the launch area, and stabilize and protect the shoreline in the aim of extending the functional life span of this public asset.

There is currently no public access through the project site, including access to and from the Lee River and access to the walking trail within the project area. The RM appreciates your patience and cooperation as these important improvements are completed.




Planning to install a deck, hot tub, or pool this spring?

Spring is around the corner! If you're planning to install a hot tub, pool, or build a deck, please note these projects require you to secure a permit before beginning the work. Our Planning Department will be able to determine whether you need a building or development permit.

Hot tubs installed on top of decks need to have engineer-stamped drawings to ensure the deck can withstand the additional weight.
