Council Decisions

June, 2023 Council expense claims approval:

Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee Lac du Bonnet Heritage Resources Management Plan approval:

- Council approved the 2023 MHAC Lac du Bonnet Heritage Resources Management Plan as presented.

Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee appointments:

- Council approved the appointment of Norm Plato as new MHAC Chairperson, John Horner as MHAC Vice-Chair, and Joan Lesko as an MHAC member, effective immediately.
- Further, Council thanked Gordon Emberley, who resigned as chairperson but will continue to serve as a member of the committee, for his years of service as chairperson (since 1991) and his continued dedication and commitment to the MHAC.

By-Law Enforcement decision:

• Council confirmed an order to remedy for a violation of the Trailer Park By-Law No. 10-20, Zoning By-Law 19-03, and a court order.

Lac du Bonnet & District Historical Society memorandum of understanding:

- Council authorized the signing of the updated MOU between the RM and the Lac du Bonnet & District Historical Society, which sets the terms and conditions for the maintenance and preservation of the Halliday Park property and Hans Erickson log cabin.
- The MOU is reviewed in five-year intervals and updated as required.

Lac du Bonnet Fire Department shed purchase:

- Council authorized the purchase of a shed from the Lac du Bonnet Lions Club for the Lac du Bonnet Fire Department's use.
- The RM is responsible for 77 per cent of the cost and the Town of Lac du Bonnet is responsible for the remaining 23 per cent.
- This expense was included in the 2023 financial plan.

Lac du Bonnet Fire Department concrete pad tender award:

- Council awarded the tender for the new Lac du Bonnet Fire Department concrete pad to Ryman and Sons Contracting. Two tenders were received.
- Further, Council approved the RM pay 50 per cent of the cost (the Town of Lac du Bonnet will pay the remaining 50 per cent.)
- Further, Council resolved the RM portion of the expense be paid from the Fire Department Reserve, as per the 2023 Financial Plan.
